Congratulations to Ryan & Brooke (Zevenbergen) Fedders who were united in marriage the past Friday. God's blessings to them as they begin their life together.

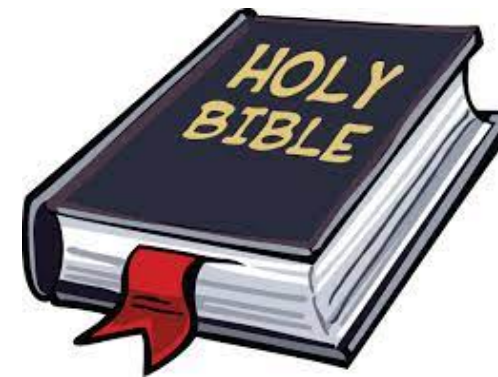
