## “The Grand Impact of Mothers”

- I. The impact of wisdom s\_\_\_\_\_ in i\_\_\_\_\_ with the teachings of a mother (v8).
- II. Solomon portrays his most v\_\_\_\_\_ of God’s gifts (That is wisdom) as a w\_\_\_\_\_ / m\_\_\_\_\_ (v20-33).
- III. A mother’s presence is like a l\_\_\_\_\_ in d\_\_\_\_\_. Her d\_\_\_\_\_ (This includes love, hope, correction, support, etc..) is like a l\_\_\_\_\_ procedure (ch6 v23).

- V. The highest praise Solomon ever gives are to m\_\_\_\_\_ who e\_\_\_\_\_ godliness (ch31:25-31).

## “How Good Leaders Encourage Pt.2”

- I. Good leaders encourage others by l\_\_\_\_\_ themselves be e\_\_\_\_\_ by the people they lead (v19).
- II. Good leaders encourage others by p\_\_\_\_\_ clear and appropriate e\_\_\_\_\_ on the people they lead (v20).
- III. Good leaders encourage others by b\_\_\_\_\_ out their z\_\_\_\_\_ (v21-24)
- IV. Good leaders encourage others by being c\_\_\_\_\_ in their j\_\_\_\_\_ or z\_\_\_\_\_ or their f\_\_\_\_\_ etc... (v25-26).
- V. Good leaders encourage others by r\_\_\_\_\_ and/or e\_\_\_\_\_ with r\_\_\_\_\_ (v27-28)
