## “Your Good Ain’t Good Enough”

- I. We must understand that the d\_\_\_\_\_ s\_\_\_\_\_ of humanity is that of s\_\_\_\_\_ (Rom 3:9-12).
- II. We must understand that we are currently s\_\_\_\_\_ and c\_\_\_\_\_. As a result, all our good deeds come out t\_\_\_\_\_ (H.C. 62).
- III. In fact, God is so holy that the best of our own “r\_\_\_\_\_” are like b\_\_\_\_\_ s\_\_\_\_\_ rags (Isaiah 64:6).
- IV. The doctrine of true g\_\_\_\_\_ does not produce a\_\_\_\_\_ or r\_\_\_\_\_ (John 15:5 H.C. 64) just as the doctrine of true l\_\_\_\_\_ does not produce a\_\_\_\_\_ or r\_\_\_\_\_.

## “The Promise of Samson”

- I. We must understand that Samson was both a p\_\_\_\_\_ of our need for salvation (Judges 13:1) as well as a f\_\_\_\_\_ of Christ (Rom 5:14).
- II. Samson’s c\_\_\_\_\_ nature (Judges 13:4-5) pointed to (Yet failed to attain) the H\_\_\_\_\_ of God.
- III. H\_\_\_\_\_ also applies to us. For if we wish to i\_\_\_\_\_ this same b\_\_\_\_\_ on our children, we too must practice c\_\_\_\_\_ for their sake (v13).
- IV. At the end of the story, we find that when our guilt may w\_\_\_\_\_ us down as parents/teachers/etc... we are told God does not meet us with c\_\_\_\_\_ but g\_\_\_\_\_ w\_\_\_\_\_ (v23).
